#### Message from the Department Commander - David W. "Spike" Gyger

I am deeply honored to lead our VFW Department during the 2023 – 2024 year. Pennsylvania has some of the best VFW leaders in the Nation and I thank you for your dedication and energy to moving our Membership Program to even greater heights.

Over the past years, we have learned that if we pay more attention to the members whose memberships are about to expire, we can easily retain them. Likewise, if their membership has expired, we can reinstate them. The trick is to be constantly aware of your Post's annual members expiration status. To help with this, make sure that your post has a monthly membership roster, and work that unpaid list monthly.

Contact the members on our rosters before their memberships lapse. We do a great job in recruiting new members to join our organization, and we need to do a better job of retaining those new members and getting them involved. It is very important that we contact those members. Give them a "buddy check" call.

Also, we need the right mix of ingredients to increase our membership numbers. First, we start with a plan to increase our membership, then we add knowledgeable recruiters to do the job. Secondly, we create recruiting opportunities while adding recruiting incentives. We are encouraging members at large to join/transfer into a local Post. A member at large listing is available for you if requested.

Membership is <u>NOT</u> just the responsibility of the officers of your post, district and/or department. It should be <u>every</u> member's highest priority. I am asking that everyone recruits at least one new member this year.

This Year's Membership Program is 101% and the Mandatory All State work sheet is required to be submitted to Department Headquarters no later than APRIL 30, 2024.

Our Department Membership team is comprised of professionally trained recruiters to help you in your post's recruiting and retention efforts. If you need assistance, reach out to one of them.

Please remember to practice the three key R's......RECRUIT, REINSTATE, RETAIN

- The membership quota for all Department contests is 101% unless otherwise noted.
- Continuous, new, reinstated and Life Members will be verified by National Headquarters for all Department Contests.
- All Department Membership Contests end April 30, 2024 unless otherwise stated. National contest ends June 30, 2024
- Individuals, Posts and Districts can only win **one** time in each **contest or category** unless otherwise stated. The Department will make the final determination of all Department awards.
- All <u>contest checks</u> will become the <u>property of the Post or District</u> unless <u>otherwise stated</u>. All checks will be made out to the Post or District Quartermaster unless otherwise stated.
- All requirements for All State Awards must be met by April 30, 2024.
- All membership transmittals for All State Status to receive a cap at Convention must be recorded at Department Headquarters NO LATER THAN April 30, 2024.
- All membership transmittals for All American Status must reach National Headquarters. Submissions must be received **NO LATER THAN June 30, 2024**.
- Please note that the requirement for National membership is 102% and FOUR Community Service Reports.
- Posts who are in arrears and receive a monetary award, the arrears will be deducted from the award.



#### Tools to Boost Membership

#### **Recruiting Tips**

- 1. Know the VFW As a recruiter, being aware of our programs and purpose will prepare you to successfully engage prospective members.
- 2. **Network for Prospects** Ask family, friends and coworkers if they know veterans who may be eligible. Follow up on leads quickly.
- 3. Make Personal Contact Try to meet prospective members face-to-face whenever possible.
- 4. **Don't Be Afraid to Ask** Many veterans have never been asked to join the VFW. If you speak up and ask them to join, you may be pleasantly surprised at their response.
- 5. Be Persistent, Not Pestering If they decline to join at this time, respect their decision.
- 6. Look for Common Experiences Ask questions to learn about military experiences, family, and daily life. Describe the benefits of membership in a way that relates to the prospective member.
- 7. **Listen Carefully** The best sales people are active listeners. Listen for excuses and objections, and then be prepared to overcome them with facts.
- 8. Share Your Story Consider why you are a part of the VFW and tell others why you are so committed to the organization. Your experiences with the VFW are the greatest recruiting tool available.
- 9. **Be Prepared** You may meet potential members anywhere so be sure to keep an application with you at all times. If you use a smartphone, learn about the VFW app and how it can be used to recruit new members. Stay current as VFW National Membership provides updates and assistance on new processes.
- 10. **Enjoy Yourself** If you are enjoying yourself, prospective members will sense your enthusiasm and be more likely to join.

#### Successful Membership Booths

The following is a general outline for setting up a successful membership recruiting booth.

#### **Start Early**

- This will work best as a joint VFW and Auxiliary operation. Cooperation is key.
- Contact the manager of a shopping mall, trade show, state or county fair, or any place there is a large public gathering. Ask for permission (or pay) for space to set up a membership booth.
- Give advance news releases to your local newspaper and radio stations regarding your membership booth.
- Place recruiting posters and signs in store windows, post signs at the entrance to your city and along major thoroughfares or any place the public will notice them.
- Obtain an adequate supply of recruiting and informational materials. Some material is available from Department and National Headquarters. Other material can be obtained from the VFW Store.

#### The Operation

- Decorate your booth with recruiting posters. Display informational material on the table. At least one VFW member and one Auxiliary member, wearing VFW caps or ball caps with Post or VFW logo, should be in the booth at all times Display a sign large enough to let everyone know you are there.
- If local and state laws allow a drawing, get a member or merchant to donate a gift. Prepare tickets with stubs that request name, address and phone number. Hold the drawing for the prize and save the stubs for later contact.
- As eligible veterans visit the booth, inform them of the VFW programs and pass out informational material.
- As eligible veterans visit the booth, have them fill out a form giving information on their military service and whether they are interested in joining the VFW. If they wish to join, SIGN THEM UP. If they don't wish to join at this time, don't be discouraged. Make sure you get their name, address and phone number and contact them at a later date.

#### The Follow Up

- Within a few days, have your membership team contact the eligible veterans and talk to them about joining the VFW. This is the time to verify their eligibility and collect their dues.
- Be sure your membership teams is prepared to answer questions about the various programs the VFW sponsors.

• When a veteran joins, make them feel welcome. Ask them to take an active part in the Post and to help recruit others.

It is not the responsibility of the Post membership team to do all of the work. Every member should be involved and made to feel a part of the membership program. Post activities attract members. A strong, active Post helps promote membership. Some membership builders are:

- Activities in community service, Americanism and youth programs.
- Capable service officer to assist veterans in the community.
- Dances, dinners and other social functions for VFW members and their guests.
- Publicize all Post events.
- Maintain a clean, well-managed Post home and canteen.
- Hold interesting and informative Post meetings.
- Have active cooperation between your Post and Auxiliary.

#### A piece of History

#### What does Gold, Blue, White and Silver Stars represent?

During World War I, an Army officer of the 5th Ohio Infantry, Captain Robert L. Queissner who had two sons serving on the front line, designed and patented the Blue Star Service Banner. This service flag/banner quickly became the unofficial symbol of a mother and/or father who had a child in military service.

Throughout WWI, American women who had family members serving their country wore a Blue star around their left arm. As the war progressed and the number of dead escalated, mothers wanted to express their loss as well as the pride and honor they felt for their country. Those mothers of the fallen began sewing a Gold Star over the blue star and they began calling themselves "Gold Star Mothers."

During World War II, the Department of War issued specifications on the manufacture of the service flag and service lapel pin. The **Blue Star** Service Banner typically displayed in windows is an 8.5x14" white field with a Blue Star(s) sewn onto a red and white banner. Each Blue Star represents one family member serving in the armed forces. A banner can have up to five stars, signifying those five members of that family are currently in military uniform on active duty.

If the family member symbolized is killed in action or dies while serving in the military, the blue star representing that individual will have superimposed on it a Gold Star of smaller size so that the blue forms a border. The traditional **Gold Star** Mothers and Families Day is the fourth Sunday in September.

A White Star Family is one who had a close relative that served in the military and lost them to suicide. The purpose of the White Star Family program is to honor those service members and provide proper care and support to the families.

The Silver Star Families are those who's loved one has been wounded, contracted a serious illness or injury in a war zone. On Silver Star Service Banner Day, traditionally May 1, we recommit to caring for those who return to us wounded or ill.

Many Gold, Blue, White and Silver Star Families reside within our community. Their sacrifice has been great and may their courage and patriotism inspire us to greater service for our country.

As members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, we ask you to remember the sacrifices of these Families as their loved ones gave their "last full measure of devotion" to preserve the ideals of a free America.

May we in grateful remembrance never forget Freedom is Not Free and that much has been sacrificed for our freedoms.

#### **Membership Mission**

To recruit, retain and mentor a stable membership base including all generations of veterans.

To cultivate a membership that is well versed in institutional knowledge and actively involved at all levels of the organization and in the local community. To establish Posts with an established vision of service, leadership, and community outreach.

#### Introduction

Today, the Veterans of Foreign Wars is 124 years old. During those years, we have had WWI, WWII, Korean, Vietnam, and other veterans joining en masse. Today, however, we have lost many of these honorable men and women. As history has proven, the Post-9/11 veterans will join our organization like others have when they are ready, however usually not until their kids grow or their retirements are in place.

We must not stereotype any of our future members regardless of sex, color, or personal beliefs. If a member qualifies, bring them in. The only way to make this success permanent is to retain those members, recover past members, and continue to recruit new veterans into our ranks. There are still many veterans eligible to join and at all ages. However, our focus needs to be on our Post-9/11 veterans, for they will be our future.

You might ask, how do we build our organization? It's simple, leadership by example. If you are a Commander of a Post, District, Department, or the National Commander, then get out there and recruit members yourself and show your team that if you can do it, so can they. A good way to do this is to improve the way we communicate with our members at all levels of the organization. Posts, Districts, Departments, and our National Officers need to use all methods available to convey information for news and training to our membership through newsletters, emails, social media, recruiting booths and outreach teams.

We need to know who our members are and how we can address their needs and concerns. It's time to step it up and recruit Post-9/11 veterans. Each of us needs to do our part and recruit at least one new member. Think about it. If we all recruit one each, we would show substantial growth in membership in just one year.

#### Department "102 Percent" Incentive

Any Department that attains 102% in membership by close of business on June 30th, 2024, will be entered into a random drawing. The commander and quartermaster that is selected will each receive:

- · Distinctive cap, citation, and name badge.
- Commander-in-Chief's Crystal Eagle.

#### New Post Development and Post Revitalization Department Award

- For each new Post chartered, and/or revitalized, the Department Quartermaster will receive:
  - A \$250 credit from the VFW Store to be used towards necessary materials for the new Post.

#### All-American Criteria

The All-American program exists to recognize exceptional leadership and teamwork, authentic accomplishment in membership growth and VFW core programs.

#### All-American Post Criteria

- Membership must be at least 102%
- Must conduct two Membership recruiting events, submit reports through All-American Dashboard
- Post-Election Report must be submitted to National Headquarters
- Meet all the following Program Participation Criteria:
  - Voice of Democracy minimum of one entry advanced to District judging (Overseas Post can donate \$100 to National in lieu of entry)
  - Patriots Pen minimum of one entry advanced to District judging (Overseas Post can donate \$100 to National in lieu of entry)
  - Hold a fundraiser with the proceeds going to Veterans & Military Support Programs Services, minimum of \$100.


